- 7. Basis of award is the total base bid (including allowance).
- 8. Construction schedule: June 17 August 23, 2024 (Construction complete); October 28, 2024 (Punchlist complete and project acceptance); January 31, 2025 Closeout complete.
- 9. The District encourages the participation of disabled veteran business enterprises ("DVBE") on all projects. The successful bidder will be required to certify that it either meets the Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise ("DVBE") goal of three percent (3%) participation or made a good faith effort to solicit DVBE participation in this Contract if it is awarded the Contract for the Work.
- **10.** Scope of work to include but not limited to:
 - a. Re-roofing of all older campus buildings (not including the high multi-purpose roof).
 - b. Campus-wide exterior paint of existing painted surfaces.
 - c. Campus-wide interior paint with custom colors per grade level.
 - d. Campus-wide security fencing including access controls at the main entry gate.
 - e. Traffic / Parking signage.
 - f. Minor / select areas of concrete removal and replacement to meet ADA
 - g. New ADA passenger-loading zone.
 - h. Additional door thresholds and sweeps where replacement concrete is done.
 - i. Removal and replacement of (e) hardcourt play area and all hardcourt play poles. New striping throughout.

- j. Replacement of underground water, sewer, and storm drain utilities located below paving to be replaced.
- k. New kinder play apparatuses within existing woodchip fall protection to remain.
- I. New main play area apparatuses with new concrete perimeter curb and poured-in-place fall-protection.
- m. New concrete perimeter curb and poured-in-place fall-protection around existing upperelementary exercise play equipment to remain.
- n. Patch-back repair and replacement of landscape and irrigation as required around new work.
- o. Remove and salvage (e) ceiling panels from the admin area to be used to replaced damaged panels at existing classrooms. Provide new ceiling panels at the admin area.
- p. Replacement hood at kitchen and associated exhaust and makeup air, with associated electrical connections and structural retrofitting as required for additional rooftop equipment.
- q. Kitchen Electrification: with required health department and code-required upgrades; including new kitchen equipment, added electrical, revised electrical, added plumbing, revised plumbing, new grease-waste interceptor, new walk-in cooler unit, replacement flooring, replacement light fixtures, and adjustments to existing overhead doors at existing service countertop openings, patch back gyp bd ceiling, paint.
