Revision of BP 5141.52 Suicide Prevention

- Suicide is the 2nd leading cause of death for youth ages 10-34 (Centers for Disease Control)
 - In Sacramento County over 20% of high school students report seriously considering suicide
- Knowing the warning signs for suicide and how to get help can help save lives
- Suicide prevention requires a comprehensive public health approach including education of our whole community (students & adults), stigma reduction, identification, crisis intervention and available resources.

Revision of BP 5141.52 Suicide Prevention

- Education Code 215 mandates that the board of any district serving students in grades 7-12 adopt a policy on student suicide prevention, intervention, and postvention (i.e., intervention conducted after a suicide) with specified components.
- The current version of Board Policy 5141.52 was adopted in 2018 and has not yet since been revised.

Revision of BP 5141.52 Suicide Prevention

 The proposed policy is intended to safeguard students and staff within the District against self-harm, suicide attempts, and deaths, and other trauma associated with suicide.

 Revisions comply with the language provided in Education Code 215 and serves students in grades TK-12.
