Sac City Kids Connect

- Extended date of 12/31/2020, to apply for Sac City Kids Connect
- Approximately 1500 students were either referred by staff as needing internet, or self reported through our WebForm
 - 30% have been offered a unique code and have been walked through the application process
 - 15% reported they are already Internet Essentials customers
 - 20% reported they no longer need internet
 - 45% are unreachable
- Revised process to support the unreachable families will include:
 - Working with internal and external partners to support a tiered approach for reaching our families
- Deadline to apply for Sac City Kids Connect is now 12/31/2020

Return to Health

Guidelines provided by CDC, CDPH, CDE, SCPH & SCOE

- Physical Distancing
- Wash Hands or Use Hand Sanitizer frequently
 - Every hour, before eating, after recess, etc.
- Use Cloth Face Coverings (6-18-2020, CDPH [updated])
 - A cloth face covering should be worn by all individuals under most circumstances, with few exceptions
 - When at least 6 feet of physical distancing is difficult to maintain, such as moving around a populated area


Return to Health

Guidelines provided by CDC, CDPH, CDE, SCPH & SCOE

- Promote Respiratory Hygiene
- Screen for symptoms
- Stay home if you are sick
 - stay home until free of symptoms for 72 hours or after ten days from the start of symptoms
 - subject to change as revised by <u>CDC</u>

Stay home if told to <u>quarantine</u> or isolate due to COVID-19

Return to Play - Athletics Update

- The Health of our students, staff, and the community is paramount
- All decisions regarding restarting our athletics programs will be based on approval provided by provided Sacramento County Health
- District has been part of Cross District Collaborative meetings
- Local districts developing return to play plans
- SCUSD gathering information, developing ideas, and beginning to work with our partners
- Guidance offered by California Interscholastic Federation (CIF), the National Federation of State High Schools Association, and Sacramento Environmental Management Department

Return to Play - Athletics Update

- Return to play models often include the following phases
 - Phase one Conditioning
 - Phase two Reintroduce equipment
 - Phase three Competitive play
- Extensive health precautions will be put in place prior to beginning any athletic programming
- We will continue to work with Sacramento County Public Health seeking guidance and approval before any plan is implemented

Burbank Urban Garden (BUG) Summer Internship Program

- Resume Summer Urban Agriculture Farm Internship
 o Follow CPHD Directives on group sizes
- All gardening is outdoors
- Standard health precautions will be implemented
- Keeps garden healthy & producing over the summer
- Allows for students to safely engage in positive, healthy, healing outdoor activities
- Provides beautiful and educational greenspace for the LBHS community
