Comment:	<p>As you know, every year there are a number of teaching positions that are vacant for more than 30 days. When senior retired teachers with full credentials do not, or cannot, take these assignments, students suffer a rotation of substitutes holding Emergency 30-Day Substitute Teaching Permits. As the COVID health crisis continues, a substantial number of senior retired teachers, serving as substitutes, may not be able to work.</p> <p>This is to request the Board, in coordination with the Superintendent and his staff, accept, review and facilitate my application for a 60-day CTC Emergency Career Substitute Teaching Permit. The CTC requires 3 years of consecutive substitute teaching with the District for at least 90 days per year; I have exceeded that with 330 days. The application form simply requires the Superintendent's signature and support.</p> <p>Unfortunately, my recent submission to Human Resources resulted in various replies that confirmed the District had never processed such an application. I then confirmed with SCTA that they had no objections to this application. I would greatly appreciate your consideration and action on this matter.</p>
