

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- Education Code EC § 80021.1 allows school districts to fill an immediate staffing need by hiring an individual who has not yet met the subject matter competence requirement needed to enter an intern program and EC § 44252(b) allows the waiver holder additional time to complete their credential requirements.
- California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CCTC)
 requires that every Provisional Internship Permit and
 Waiver request go through a public notice process at the
 local level and must be Board approved in a public meeting
 prior to the submission of the employing agency to CCTC

School Years 2016/2017, 2017/2018, 2018/2019, 2019/2020, and 2020/2021 Emergency Credential Requests



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- These provisional internship permits and waivers will enable these teachers the opportunity to complete the requirements set forth by CCTC and to remain in their positions while they continue their work with students
- The Provisional Internship Permit is being requested for the following Education Specialist teacher as she completes her Subject Matter requirements for an Intern Credential
 - Crystal Hamilton Education Specialist
- Waivers are being requested for the following elementary teachers as they complete their Basic Skills requirements to clear their Out-of-State Multiple Subject Preliminary Credentials
 - Anaissa Herrera Teacher, Elementary
 - Jessica Johnson Teacher, Elementary

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- Given our current state of Distance Learning, approving this Permit and these Waivers will afford the District to maintain consistency of the teachers in the classrooms.
- Due to COVID-19, in part, the teachers have not been able to complete the necessary steps to meet the CCTC requirements. Approval of these items will allow the teachers additional time to meet their credential requirements.
- Staff recommends approving this Permit and these Waivers.
