**RESOLUTION NO. 3176**

**ADOPTION OF CONDITIONS OF READINESS  
FOR THE RE-OPENING OF SCHOOL**

**WHEREAS**, the Superintendent, through various departments of the District, presented for public comment and Board discussion a list of requirements for the re-opening of the District's schools at the Board meeting on November 5, 2020 including an oral presentation and a PowerPoint; and

**WHEREAS**, a second presentation by the Superintendent, through various departments of the District, was presented for public comment, Board discussion, and for Board action on November 19, 2020 including an oral presentation and a PowerPoint, a list of requirements as conditions of readiness for the re-opening of District schools which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as Attachment A ("conditions of readiness for school re-opening"); and

**WHEREAS**, the District's students have been engaged in distance learning since March 16, 2020 and continue in that model currently; and

**WHEREAS**, the District will continue discussions with its labor partners to return students and all staff to our schools for in person learning when these conditions of readiness are met and state and local public health orders allow it; and

**WHEREAS**, these conditions of readiness for school re-opening are intended to make safe, as much as possible, our students, families, employees and community from COVID-19 and that the District has complied with the requirements by state and local public health orders, including extra measures to ensure that our schools are safe when our students return to in-person learning.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Sacramento City Unified School District Board of Education which finds and determines as follows:

1. Adopts the foregoing recitals as true and correct.
2. Adopts the conditions of readiness for school re-opening (Attachment A) and any Board amendments adopted at the Board meeting, subject to any subsequent Board amendments based upon any subsequently revised Executive Orders of the Governor, orders and directives of the California Department of Public Health, the orders and directives of the Sacramento County Public Health Department and Health Officer of the County of Sacramento, and all other relevant public authorities.
3. Directs the Superintendent to monitor and report back to the Board at future Board meetings regarding the implementation of readiness of school re-opening and any subsequent amendments to the conditions of readiness for school re-opening as may be needed for the re-opening of the District's schools.

4. Directs the Superintendent to recommend to the Board when it is safe to re-open the District's schools, including a recommended plan and timeline, whether by hybrid, gradual re-opening or other recommendation based upon changing health and safety factors related to COVID-19 pandemic developments, and orders and directives referenced in section 2.
