Re: Bargaining Effects of Reopening Schools

Dear Mr. Fisher:

We are in receipt of your email dated June 10, 2020 requesting that we meet to schedule a time to talk about the reopening of our District schools that have an early start date— New Joseph Bonnheim and New Tech High School. We agree with SCTA that discussing this issue is critically important, as is discussing the plan and process for reopening all of our District schools on September 3, 2020.

As you pointed out during our negotiations session on June 9, 2020, the early start date for these two schools makes these discussions urgent. To that end, we propose that the District's negotiations team meet with representatives from SCTA's negotiations team to specifically discuss options related to reopening our District schools with an early start date. This will also allow us the opportunity to hear any questions that SCTA has about reopening schools and for the District to share information that it has around reopening schools.

We propose that we schedule this session for June 19, 22 or 23, 2020 from 4:00 to 5:00 p.m. Please let us know if any of these dates and times works for the SCTA team.
