Dear Mr. Fisher:

This letter follows the negotiations session between the District and SCTA on June 9, 2020, which was the second meeting between our respective negotiation teams on successor contract negotiations. We appreciate SCTA's willingness to receive information from the District's Chief Business Officer Rose Ramos on the District's budget and hear her responses to your questions during that session. We also appreciate SCTA providing the four proposals you shared during that session.

The District would like to schedule another date for our respective bargaining teams to continue successor contract negotiations so that the District can respond to the four proposals you shared on June 9th and receive any counterproposals from SCTA on the District's proposals presented to you between August and December 2019 and reviewed with the SCTA negotiation team at our negotiations meeting on March 3, 2020. Please let me know by Friday, June 19, 2020, if SCTA is available to meet for successor contract negotiations on any of the following dates and times: June 24 or 26, 2020, at 4:00 p.m.

The District continues to believe that together, with SCTA and our other labor partners, and through the collective bargaining process, solutions to our budget challenges that are acceptable for the District and our employees will be identified and agreed to, thereby allowing the District and its employees to continue the shared goal of enhancing educational opportunities for all students.
