Please choose one of the three school templates for your home page. All three templates have similar features and have different layouts.

Website Features

- Image Carousel (similar to SCUSD.edu) that rotates between 2-5 images.
- 3 Static Story Blurbs under the Carousel section – these are often used for upcoming events and ongoing school initiatives or fundraisers.
- Quick Links section – have up to eight links for easy access. These can link to a page on the website or another website.
- Welcome message – a short message from your principal or introduction to the school
- Link to District Website and optional links to Facebook or Twitter page
- Staff roster page
- School calendar page
- Email newsletter capability
- Optional Report an Absence form (can be customized)

School Branding

Once you decide on a template, we will customize your website with your school's colors and use your logo, mascot or image of the school to customize the top banner for you. The registration form requires you to upload one of the three images types depending on your template choice.

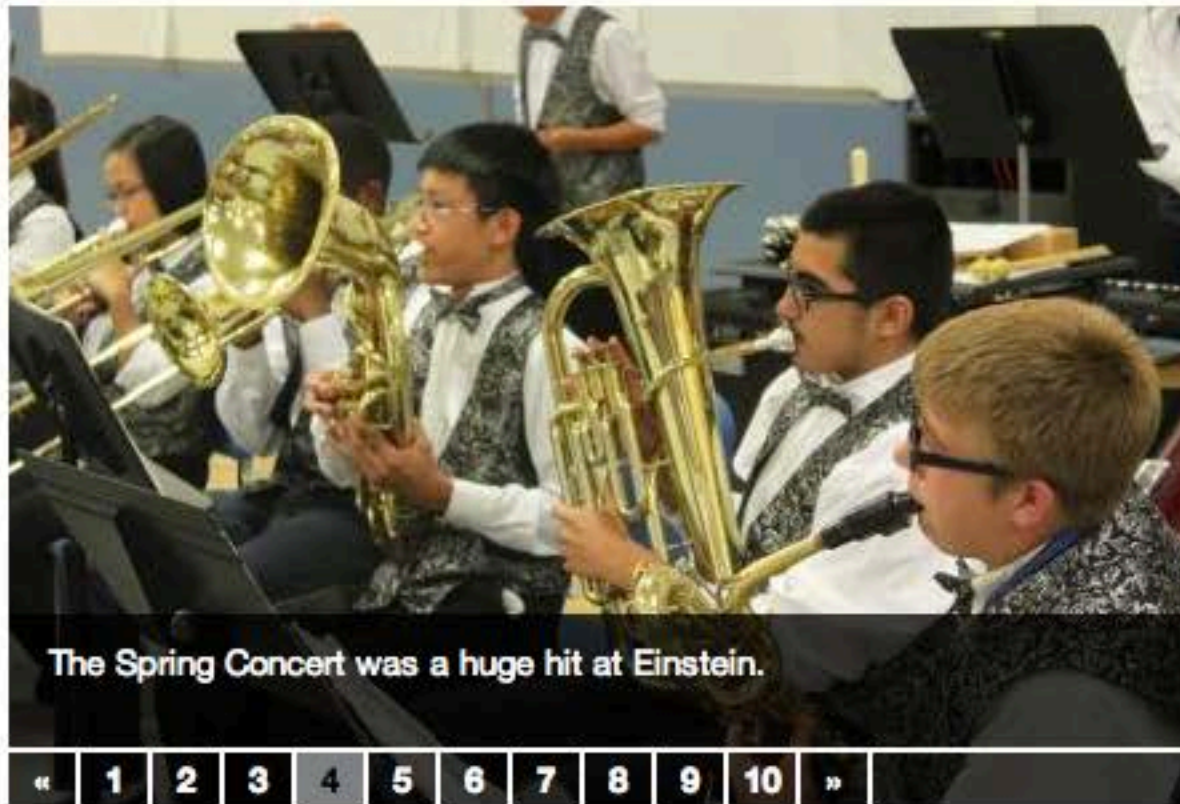
Explore. Discover. Create.

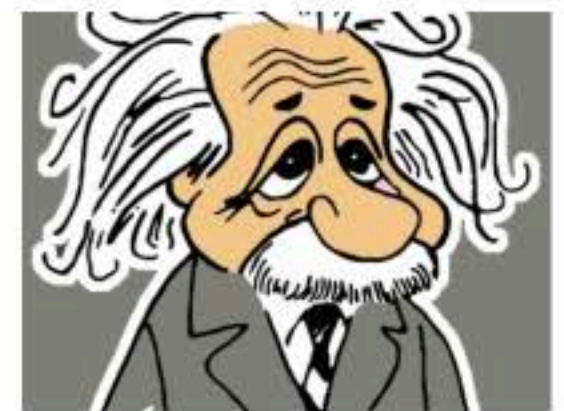
Robotics
